Introduction

This manual is specified for use with full body harnesses (FBH's) mfg. by Super Anchor Safety®, does not replace SAS harness instruction manuals, and does not apply to FBH's mfg. by others. Persons assigned to inspect safety equipment or oversee safety, may include additional inspection points that apply to job specific uses or hazard exposure not specified in SAS harness instruction manuals that are supplied at the time of purchase.

OSHA and ANSI fall protection standards require that fall protection equipment is to be inspected at least once a year by a qualified or competent person as defined by OSHA. In the event a FBH is subjected to a free fall, damaged due to abuse or poor storage, or fails basic inspection requirements, it is required be removed from service and disposed of in a way that will prevent further use.

Symbols are used to designate areas of inspection and specify required function tests of connectors.

⊗ = Inspection point **←** = Stitching inspection.

E = Function test required.

For example: Inspection points ① shown adjacent to a harness component name, image or Fig. no., have a corresponding definition on page 2 of this manual. The same inspection numbers are listed on the harness inspection form 1.0 as a checklist to confirm if the harness component passes or fails inspection.
